


DUES

Fort Donelson Monument Status

We have received a formal response from the Superintendent of the Fort Donelson National Battlefield. He and his team of park staff, historians, and archeologists have questioned the position of the sculptured soldier and suggest a minor change in the proposed location. The Monument Committee is working on a redesign of the sculpture and hopes to be able to submit a revised proposal soon. We have recently received information from the sculptor, Fred Hoppe, and hope to respond to the NPS soon.
